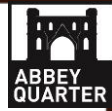

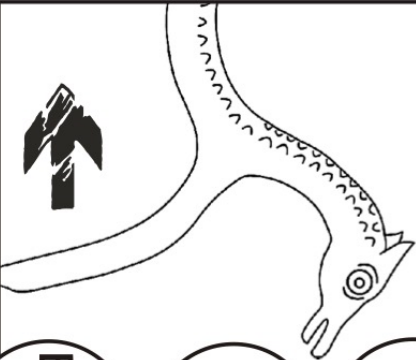

Have a cold bath?

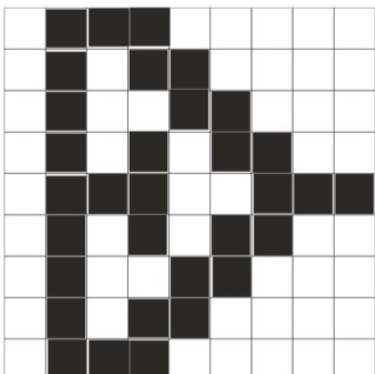
Have a warm bath?

What is it called?

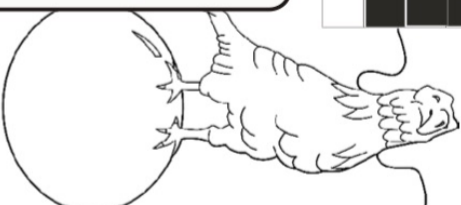
Can you find the Roman Dining room? In front of the lounge are some small mosaic tiles; can you make the following mosaic?
